

Your church can bring life in all its fullness, by releasing the power of the local church



They worked hard to farm their land and raise their children, but struggled to make a living and could barely afford to put food on the table – let alone pay for school fees or medicine when their children aot sick.

'In the past, it was difficult for us to make money. We couldn't send the children to school, pay for the transportation fares. We couldn't send them to hospital or buy the medicines for our children.'

The local church: ending extreme poverty and injustice

For more than 50 years, Tearfund has seen how local churches can bring effective and lasting transformation to whole communities. Churches are often best placed to address extreme poverty – they understand the needs and strengths of their communities, and are able to reach some of the most vulnerable groups.

Tearfund's Church and Community Transformation training brings change that is both sustainable and empowering. It is through the training that the local church, working with its local community, recognises the skills and resources God has given them to overcome poverty from within and build greater resilience, with immediate effect.

When churches and communities are empowered to fulfil their God-given potential, everything changes.




Rene and Odile's story

'In the past, we were falling sick, children were falling sick and they were sick all the time,' explains Rene. 'When we cannot sell our products and when people are sick, you are afraid.'

Although the family went to church, Jesus' promise of life 'to the full' seemed a long way off. But Tearfund's Church and Community Transformation training helped the congregation to realise and unlock their God-given potential. Through prayer and Bible study, Rene and Odile's local church learnt that, with God, the power to overcome poverty was possible.

The couple received training on savings and farming. They learnt to diversify their crops – rotating between pineapples and yams – and today they have a thriving pineapple business with a good yield throughout the year.

'God has blessed us. Today, I can send my children to school,' says Rene. 'Today, I am building. Today, I can use money to buy fish, to buy a bag of rice. So I can say that a real change has come.'

Training up a local church breaks poverty's grip

Rene and Odile's story is just one example of a family realising through Tearfund's Church and Community Transformation training that God has given them what they need to lift themselves out of extreme poverty. We are seeing stories of transformation, like this, in the places we work, all over the world.

Poverty is a complex issue and, at Tearfund, we believe it is a consequence of four broken relationships which stem from the fall: our relationship with God, our relationship with each other, our relationship with ourselves, and our relationship with creation. The role of the church is to help restore these relationships, and we call this integral mission. This approach addresses the holistic needs of a person – physical, emotional, spiritual, economic, environmental, and social.

Local church members receive training to facilitate Bible studies that help them understand the root causes of poverty. These studies encourage people to recognise the church's mandate to help restore the four broken relationships, address the practical needs in their communities, and identify the resources they have available to respond.

A recent independent study into the impact of Tearfund's training through local churches found that:



27 per cent of participants are more satisfied with their lives in general.



Every £1 that Tearfund invests in Church and Community Transformation training unlocks £7 of additional resources within a community.



9 out of 10 communities who participated in the training built new or improved community assets such as schools, roads or access to water.



Tearfund's Church and Community Transformation training is sustainable, empowering, biblically based and cost-effective.
