- Act as the first point of contact for site administration for other volunteer teams.
- Maintain the hospitality area: restocking snacks and drinks, tidying up and cleaning

- Attend a training session on site.
- Look out for your own spiritual and wellbeing needs and those of your team around you.
- Attend team prayer time each day. This is a great opportunity to meet together as a team, to support and encourage one another.
