PURPOSE OF THE EXHIBITION STAND

The exhibition stand is an opportunity to share the vision Tearfund has to see the local church overcoming poverty. Sometimes this will look like a financial ask to support Tearfund, other times it might be to sign up to pray or campaign.

We're keen to place each volunteer in a role they will enjoy and suit them. Volunteers at the exhibition stand must be comfortable talking to a variety of people at the event, to share with them our vision and ask for support with confidence. You'll also need to be on your feet and willing to work flexible shifts, often in the evenings. We promise to make sure you have regular breaks and don't spend more than two and a half hours at a time on the stand.

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Working on the Exhibition Stand

- Proactively engage new and current supporters
- To encourage and update current supporters about how Tearfund is working across the world.
- Be an excellent ambassador for Tearfund at all times.

Contribute to the team

- Attend initial on-site briefing run by Events Team staff
- Look out for your own spiritual needs and those of your team around you.
- Attend team prayer time each day. This is a great opportunity to meet together as a team, to support and encourage one another. If you would be interested in running one of these sessions please let the Events Team know. We aim to have someone different run the prayers each day.

We are looking for people who are passionate about telling the world about God's heart for justice and Tearfund's work in following Him.

- Enthusiastic, confident and outgoing person who wants to communicate Tearfund to the delegates.
- Good knowledge of & enthusiastic about Tearfund.
- Excellent interpersonal skills - relational and sensitive in dealing with members of the public.
- Ability to use initiative and have a positive attitude.
- Committed to achieving the objectives and willing to learn and adapt throughout the event.
